## Questions to Ask Before, During... Before: and After Reading

- What do you think this story will be about?
- What do you think might happen in the story?

During:

- What is happening in the picture?
- Cover a word...What word do you think will

come next?

### After:

- Can you retell the story (beginning, middle, and end)?
- Does in the book seem familiar to you?
