# Questions to Ask Before, During... and After Reading

## Before:

- ◆ What do you think this story will be about?
- ◆ What do you think might happen in the story?

## During:

- ◆ What is happening in the picture?
- ◆ Cover a word...What word do you think will
- ◆ come next?

## After:

- ◆ Can you retell the story (beginning, middle, and end)?
- ◆ Does in the book seem familiar to you?
